Mayor Blue soon learns something troubling. The sneaky Scrambler has captured the Super 6.

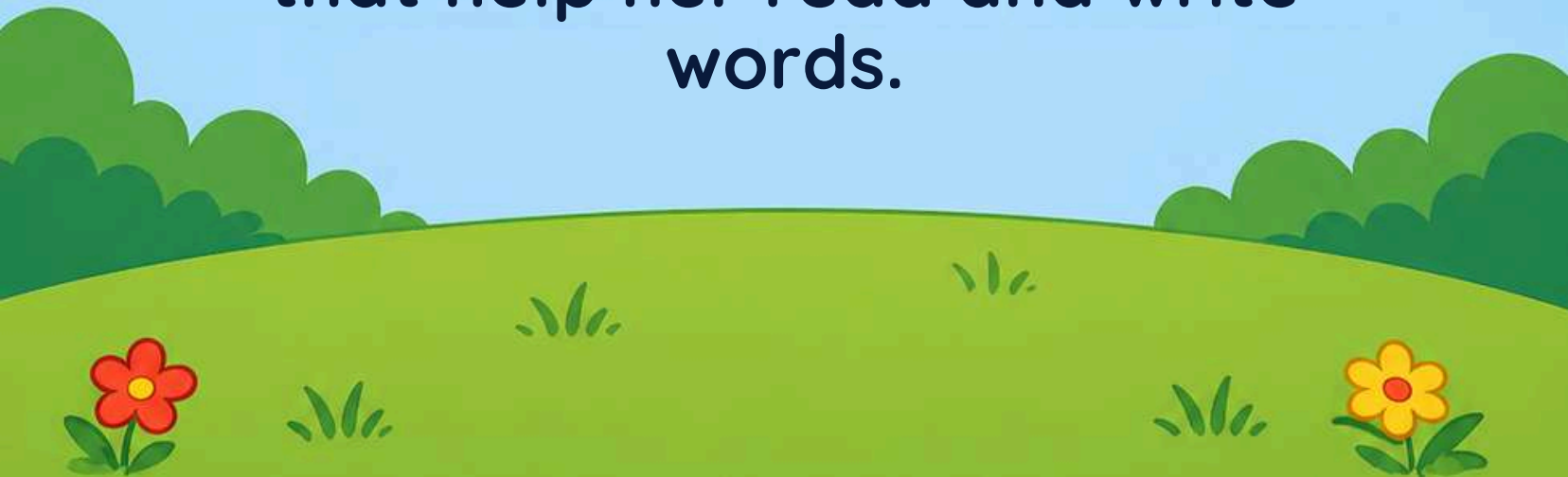


Without the Super 6
